* – Countries, which territories are only partially covered by EMS delivery.

On calculating the period of delivery of EMS parcels, containing commodities, one should add to the estimated delivery time 24 hours of the customs processing and clearance.

The processing time does not include the filing date, as well as weekends and public holidays

The delivery of international EMS items in a destination country is carried out in accordance with the office hours of a destination country's EMS service.
